And thou art crowned at last.

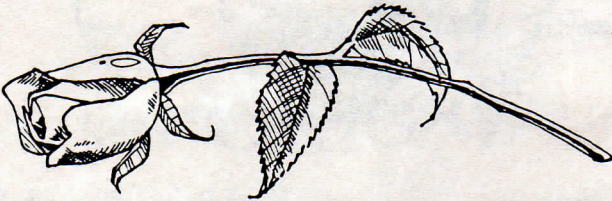
A Treasured Pearl
